

Workshop: The Perpetual Beginner

How to keep learning for a lifetime.

Do you play *with* your instrument more than play it?

Do you feel like you still struggle to improve after months or years of playing?

This workshop looks at the keys to real improvement as a player, and the mindset and tools that allow you to keep growing. Everyone gets stuck sooner or later, but you can learn to get out of playing ruts by changing how you think and how you work. Sometimes that means forgetting what you think you know, and going back to the things that made you want to play in the first place.

This workshop explores this idea in depth, applying the concept to practicing, choosing material, performance, and even how you listen.
